NOTICE OF RACE

Southern Yacht Club (SYC)

1. RULES

The Race will be governed by the 2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and The Leukemia Cup Regatta Sailing Instructions, which will be available at the Skippers Meeting. Southern Yacht Club and Pontchartrain Yacht Club will administer the Race.

2. FLEETS

PHRF: Spinnaker, Non-Spinnaker and Multi-Hull. Class breaks will be defined at the Skippers Meeting. Four valid entries are necessary to establish a class.

ONE DESIGN KEEL BOATS: Four valid entries are necessary to establish a class.

OPTIMIST & BOARD BOATS: Four valid entries are necessary to establish a class.

3. RACE FORMAT & LOCATION

All racing will be conducted on custom courses with fixed or temporary marks on the South Shore of Lake Pontchartrain approximately one (1) nautical mile north of SYC.

4. ADVERTISING

The regatta is designated Category A in accordance ISAF Regulation 20 for all classes. Racers may upgrade to Category C which allows advertising if their boat raises \$250 or more; there will be no additional entry fee for Category C.

5. ELIGIBILITY

Competitors: The race is open to all. Competitors need not be a member of a yacht club.

PHRF Boats: Participating PHRF boats must have a current GYA PHRF certificate. Boats without a current GYA PHRF certificate will be assigned a temporary rating by the Race Committee equal to the GYA rating for similar boats, less six (-6) seconds per mile. Boats without a current GYA PHRF Certificate may apply for a certificate online at:

<http://java46.homestead.com/OnLineApp.html> Boats that do not meet the GYA PHRF definition of a Standard PHRF Boat may sail under a GYA S-PHRF certificate. S-PHRF certificates may be obtained online at the above link.

PHRF: Three races will be attempted; one race constitutes a series.

One Design Keel Boats: Five races will be attempted; two races constitute a series.

No race will be started after 1500.

Awards Ceremony: At Southern Yacht Club, following conclusion of racing.

9. REGISTRATION

Registration forms will be emailed to past entrants, and are available at area Yacht Clubs, on area yacht club websites, or by calling The Leukemia & Lymphoma Society office at (504) 837-0945. Competitors are urged to register early so that the Race Committee can assign accurate class breaks, prepare race packets, order t' shirts, etc...

Protests will be heard by the Protest Committee according to the Sailing Instructions.
